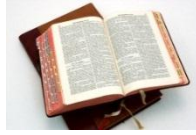
Time Change for Adult Bible Study

CrossWalk

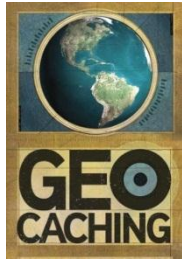

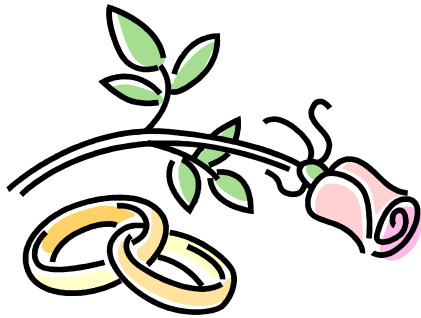
