New Business

Discuss order of service for summer services (Julie G.)
Continued study of Romans 8 & Galatians. Work of the Holy Spirit. Revised Common Lectionary goes back to topics prior to Easter—will not use for summer. Recommendation to use Here is Bread verse 1 for Holy Communion “liturgy”.
